Entries

Districts are invited to send a team of three competitors, mixed 2 boys & 1 girl or 2 girls & 1 boy.

Auckland / North Harbour are entitled to nominate two teams.

Selection Criteria

Competitors must be NZ Citizens or have proof of NZ residency and must be under 17 years of age at 30th September 2026.

Travel & Accommodation

Travel by Air into Auckland Airport, other public transport or private cars.
These travel costs for Districts to Auckland are covered by The Eagles Golfing Society of NZ. Transfers to Windross Farm Golf Club and accommodation will be provided by Eagles Golfing Society of Auckland & North Harbour.

All competitors will be accommodated at Bruce Pulman Lodge, Te Aparangi Road, Takanini, Auckland 2112. Pulman Lodge offers upscale sports group accommodation situated on Park grounds featuring studio rooms, large dormitory & bunk style rooms ideal for sports teams. The accommodation is approximately 10 minutes drive from Windross Farm Golf Course.

Chaperones are welcome although they will have to arrange their own accommodation as there is no available accommodation at Bruce Pulman Lodge.

Following the presentation of Prizes and completion of the Tournament, those Districts flying will depart on Wednesday evening 7th October - (depending on connecting flights).
